

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Steamboat Outhouse Facility Maintenance

Located on the Alaska Hwy 81km (50 miles) NW of Fort Nelson

This service agreement commences on May 1, 2009 and terminates on April 30, 2010 and with the Northern Rockies Regional Municipality retaining the option of extending the agreement for the following:

May 1, 2010 – April 30, 2011

May 1, 2011 – April 30, 2012

The scope of work for this agreement is to provide janitorial services for the Steamboat Outhouse facility – toilet (1), including general grounds cleanup and snow removal that will provide adequate access to the facility.

The frequency of this service is

- Three times per week from May 1 to October 1
- One time per week from October 1 through to April 30

This rate is to include travel, materials and labor costs for each year.
