WHEN DO I NEED A BUILDING PERMIT?

Building Permits are required BEFORE you:

- Construct a new home
- Build decks over 10m² (107ft²), 600mm (24") above grade, attached to building
- Do plumbing installation/alteration
- Demolish, relocate or move a building
- Make additions to an existing building

- Construct a chimney or install a woodstove or insert
- Construct retaining walls over 1.2 m
 (4ft) in height
- Construct an accessory building greater than 10m² (107ft²)
- Site a pre-manufactured home (Modular/Mobile)

MANY HOME RENOVATIONS REQUIRE A BUILDING PERMIT.

FAILURE TO OBTAIN A PERMIT BEFORE STARTING

CONSTRUCTION MAY RESULT IN DELAYS OR A FINE

Building Permits are NOT required for minor, non-structural modifications such as:

- X Cabinet replacement
- **X** Painting
- **X** Flooring
- Roofing repairs or re-roofing (third party inspection recommended)
- Decorative finish repair or replacement
- Retaining walls under 1m (3.3ft) in height
- Fences under 1.8m (6ft)
- Structures less than 10m² (107ft²⁾
