



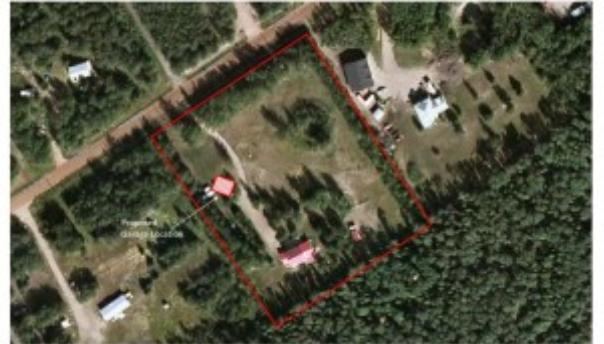

NRRM Recognized for Excellence in Asset Management

AT THE 2016 conference held in May, The Canadian Network of Asset Managers (CNAM) recognized the Northern Rockies Regional Municipality and Kerr Wood Leidal Consulting Engineers (KWL) by awarding them the 2016 Tereo award for excellence in Asset Management.

The establishment of the NRRM's Asset Management System (AMS) was catalyzed by the signing of the Infrastructure Development Contribution Agreement in 2013, marking an important milestone in committing to service-oriented, full life-cycle infrastructure management across the municipality.

The AMS has proven to be an extremely beneficial tool that provides the NRRM with the data required in order to apply analytic decisions relating to major capital investments, giving consideration to stakeholder interests, economic conditions and

REGIONAL COUNCIL Resolved to submit a UBCM *Wildfire Prevention Initiative* grant funding application in 2017 to update the 2012 NRRM Fort Nelson Community Wildfire Protection Plan.
