### Vermicomposting Update

AN UPDATE TO THE Vermicomposting Trial was presented to Council noting that the trial began August 9, 2017 and reached its target weight of 70,000 kilograms by September of 2017 (all locally sourced). The trial was expanded this fall to accept further organic drop-offs from residents.

It is expected that Regional Council will review the final business case for full scale vermicomposting later this year.
