Drop-In Sports Users

All of the following are unsupervised activities and are for use at your own risk. These times are for all skill levels and are free of charge, so please be mindful of other users and the facility rules. All sports will take place on a concrete surface, appropriate footwear and padding is recommended.

Pickleball

Equipment & basic game rules can be borrowed at no charge from the front reception desk during business hours.

Roller Skating/Blading

Skates are MANDATORY for all ages during this time and CSA certified helmets are MANDATORY for children under 8 and highly recommended for all skaters.

Roller Hockey

Roller hockey is an informal type of hockey played concrete while wearing roller skates/blades on ice. Body-checking and lifting or "roofing/reefing/raising the puck" (shooting the puck or ball so it rises above the floor) are forbidden because the players are not wearing protective equipment. Roller skates/blades and CSA certified helmets are MANDATORY for all ages and full hockey gear is highly recommended. Players must bring their own equipment. Players must use a stick with a plastic blade, or a fiberglass ball hockey stick.

Ball Hockey

Players must bring their own equipment. CSA certified helmets are recommended for all players. Players must use a stick with a plastic blade, or a fiberglass ball hockey stick. Soccer shin guards are the minimum recommended pads to participate.
