In support of the 2021/2022 harvesting program, the Fort Nelson Community Forest is seeking qualified contractors to complete pile-burning activities on two blocks located on the pipeline bypass road.

Scope of work

3	26	20 X 10	Truck
4	17	20 X 10	Truck

All burn piles must be infrared scanned and cold trailed prior to December 15th, 2024.

Pricing

Please provide lump sum pricing per block, inclusive of labour, materials and expenses required to complete burning activities. All piles burning must completed by December 15th, 2024

Required Qualifications

Contractors must be SAFE certified by the BC Forest Safety Council. All workers must have, at a minimum, S-100 and S-185.
